Country vs City Teams Matches Sunday 5th April 2009

- The Country vs City teams matches will be held on Sunday commencing at 8.30 a.m.
- The venue will be the Duncan Range at Belmont.
- Ranges will be 2 sighters and 10 shots to count at 300/600/900 and 1000 yards.
- Programme for the day: 300/600/900, free barbeque, 1000 yards, and presentations after lunch.
- Team sizes will be as follows:-
 - Open Teams: Captain, 3 Coaches and 15 shooters all to count.
 - Veterans Teams: Captain, Coach and 5 shooters all to count.
 - Ladies Teams: Captain, Coach and 5 shooters all to count.
 - Under 25 Teams: Captain, Coach and 5 shooters all to count.
 - F-class Standard Teams: Captain, Coach and 5 shooters all to count.
 - F-class Open Teams: Captain, Coach and 5 shooters all to count.

N.B. Captains and coaches may be shooters as well.

The Board recognises that teams of this size may be a big ask and we may have to start with teams of smaller numbers, but we certainly hope that the above can be achieved.

- Perpetual Trophies will be presented for all matches.
- ***The QRA will meet all costs (excluding travel and ammunition) for these matches including markers, range officer, butts officer, site usage fees.***
- ***The QRA will provide bunk house accommodation for country members free of charge for this event. Barbeque lunch will be at QRA cost.***
- Country shooters shooting in these Teams' Matches on Sunday may book practice targets for the Saturday afternoon by contacting Helen Griffiths MDRA President, Ph. 07 3821 5969, or may shoot with MDRA clubs if they wish.
