Open to all affiliated members of the NRAA. State Association membership card may be required.

Other competitors are welcome upon proof of membership of an Association with satisfactory insurance cover (eg SSAA). * \$10.00 daily fee for non NRAA members.

F class standard competitors should ensure that they are aware of requirements for this class as set out in NRAA Standard Shooting Rules. Non compliance will automatically require entry in F (Open).

DIRECTIONS: The Bundaberg-Burnett Rifle Range is part of a Shooting Complex (small blue sign) 2693 Isis Highway, about 26km between Childers and Bundaberg. It is opposite the Gliding Club sign.

From the south, travel to Apple Tree Creek and go OVER the flyover to Bundaberg. Turn right at about 26 km.

From the north, either continue along the Bruce Highway until Apple Tree Creek and turn left to Bundaberg OR turn left from Gin Gin to South Kolan and turn right onto Cedars Creek crossing road to the Isis Highway. Then turn right. At the forestry lookout tower, slow down. You will have to turn left if you follow the Sth Kolan route.

ACCOMMODATION: Free camping on the range. Donation welcome for electricity usage. *Limited outside connections for vans.* Toilets and hot showers on site. Motels and caravan parks available at Bundaberg and Childers. Childers Gateway Motor Inn (07 4126 1288). Cordalba Hotel (07 4126 6205) is about 10 km South of the shooting range. Riverside Retreat (07 4155 1471) on Isis Highway \$15.40 (inc GST) per night bunk type accommodation. Bundaberg International Motor Inn (07 4151 2366) Takalvan St. Bundaberg..
