At the February Meeting of the NRAA, the Board approved the following rule changes. These changes complete the integration of F Open shooting onto Standard Target and scoring systems the same as F Standard. The November 2010 National Workshop of all States requested this and the NRAA looks forward to the increasing growth of the F Open Discipline.

As from 1st June 2011 the following rules have been amended to read as follows:-.

Specifically:-

1. Rule 20.1.1.22 has been altered to read:-

“Targets:

Normal full-bore targets will be used. An extra point will be scored for each centre bull.”

(The above replaces the F Open Championship Target with the Standard Target, the same as Rule 20.1.2.22 for F Standard)

2. Remove Rule 20.1.1.24 *(This removes reference to F Open style spotters)*
3. Remove Rule 20.1.1.25 *(This removes reference to F Open Value Discs & Wands)*
4. Remove Rule 20.1.1.26 *(This removes all references to specific F Open Targets)*

5. Rule 20.1.1.27 be altered to read,

“Sighting Shots:

Unless specified in the match conditions, the competitor shall be entitled to two convertible sighting shots for each match.”

(The above changes 3 sighters to 2 sighters)

6. Alter Rule 13.6 to read:- *(This below adds the words "F Open" into the normal scoring process)*

"The introduction of a "Super V" is to be implemented, effective immediately, for competition as required. The Super V will consist of a circular patch inside the V Bull comprising half the diameter of the V Bull. Scoring on the score card of a Super V for F Standard and **F Open** competitors only, will be marked as an "X", all other scoring remains without change i.e., V - 5 - 4 - 3 - 2, plus the inclusion of a score of 1 on ICFRA targets where applied. To value shots on the target from the butts the "Super V" will be indicated at 3 o'clock with a red marking disc and for a score of 1 by indicating the value on the edge of the target at 9 o'clock in the middle. The spotting disc for indicating a Super V shall be white." The Super V will be valued as 6.1 and the Super V count will be used for tie breaking purposes only.
