It is a sunny day at present at Belmont.

### **QRA Update 2 Apr 09**

Over the past 12 hours we have had torrential rain at Belmont (photos will be posted on the website). As a result some changes have been made to the plan for the activities on the weekend.

Firstly, the MDRA will now shoot at 600 instead of 300 yards as it is the only firing point with reasonable wet weather access, at this stage. Parking should be available behind the firing point between the flag poles. We are not able to park any further West of the flag line between target 28 and 29 due to the shotgun template overlapping onto the Duncan Range. We cannot park East of the flag line between targets 14 and 15 as that area is flooded. Targets 4 to 18 are being used.

For the Champion of Champions on Saturday morning the ranges will be double 600, 900 and 1000 yards. Parking will be available behind 600 as described above, with parking for 900 and 1000 on the right hand side of the road (near the toilet block) and shooters walking to the firing points. Targets 4 to 13 are being used.

The Teams matches will also be double 600, 900 and 1000 yards with the same parking restrictions as above. Targets 11 to 28 are being used with a gap from 19 to 22 where the electronic targets have been installed.

It is not intended to open the back gate due to new earthworks behind 1000, during the weekend.

An assessment of the range conditions will again be made tomorrow so that a decision can be made no later than 4.00 pm whether the matches for the weekend can proceed. We are conscious of the need to give country shooters as much warning as possible should it be necessary to call off the shoots.

A message will be posted by this means and on the website to advise if cancellation is necessary or more preferably, that the matches will still be going ahead.
